- THE REVISED ICC RULES -

Established in 1923 the arbitration body of the International Chamber of Commerce (ICC) has long been the world's leading organization in the field of international commercial dispute resolution. Only last year, close to 800 new cases were filed with the ICC and close to 500 awards were rendered.

In 2008, the ICC created a task force composed of over 175 members from 41 different countries, to determine to what extent amendments to the ICC Rules would be useful or necessary. As a result of this work, a revision to the ICC Rules has recently been adopted and will be launched in early 2012.

The SAA hereby invites its members to an evening seminar on the revised ICC Rules. The seminar will focus on the main revisions concerning: emergency arbitrator; prima facie determination of jurisdiction; multiparty and multicontract provisions; joinder of additional parties and consolidation; confidentiality; and case management techniques. Comparisons will be made to the SCC Rules and to the new IBA Rules of Evidence.
